Project Description

Development Response to Displacement Impacts Project Phase II (DRDIP II) is implementing in 6 refugee hosting regional state of Ethiopia. These are Afar, Amhara, Benishangulgamuz, Gambella, Somali and Tigray regions. Both the host and refugee communities are the direct beneficiary of the project and a total of 2,504,952 communities will be benefited which constituting 1,759,514 host and 745,438 refugees.

Project Components and Subcomponents

The project has five main components and nine subcomponents. The main components are:

- Social and economic services
- Infrastructure, Sustainable environmental Management
- Sustainable livelihood program,
- Project Management, Monitoring and Evaluation Learning;
- Contingent Emergency Response



Project Development Objective (PDO)

To improve access to basic social and economic services, expand livelihood opportunities and enhance environmental management for host communities and refugees in the target areas.

Key Expected Outcomes and Outcome Indicators
The project has 3 main expected PDO level outcomes indicators. These are:

- 1** 2,504,952 beneficiaries with access to social and economic services and infrastructure.
- 2** 50 Percent of the livelihood beneficiaries whose income increases by 25% or more (disaggregated by refugee/host community status and gender).
- 3** 40,000 hectares of land area under sustainable landscape management practices.



Implementation Approach

The project is a multilevel and multisectoral investment. Which is implemented in the existing government structures using Community Driven Development (CDD) approach to actively involve the beneficiary communities in problem identification, prioritization, planning, implementation and monitoring.
