The Participatory Agriculture and Climate Transition Program

The Participatory Agriculture and Climate Transition Program of the Ministry of Agriculture links agriculture and climate to support sustainable change in agriculture. PACT program has been approved by the Government and has begun its operation in 2024.

The programme has three key components, namely community led, climate smart productive land scape; Agribusiness development; Institutional and Policy Strengthening and Implementation Support Services. It is a seven-year programme covering the period b/n 2024 and 2030. Programme regions are nine regional states of Amhara, Oromia, South west Ethiopia, Sidama, Somali, Afar, Tigray Central Ethiopia and South Ethiopia, and 90 selected woredas. The total budget of the program is nearly 180 million USD.

- Climate resilient infrastructure development
- Development of improved farmers led SSI systems
- Development of multiple-use water systems
- Rehabilitation of water infrastructure
- Local market-related infrastructure development
- Rehabilitation/upgrading of existing water infrastructure

- Supporting farmer/pastoral training centers
- Demonstration of new agricultural technologies and improved practices on model farmer's plot
- Crop production and productivity improvement
- Gender equality and social inclusion provisions (GESI)
- Integrated rangeland restoration & rehabilitation
- Fodder bank establishment and management
- Red meat production from goat & sheep
- Poultry (Egg and Chicken Meat) production
- Nutrition sensitive agriculture CSA
